

Travel advice and directions SCSS 2025

For a trouble-free journey it is highly recommended to check possible connections ahead of time at <https://int.bahn.de/en> or in the app ([IOS](#) | [Play Store](#)).

Due to construction works between Essen and Dortmund and at Bochum central station in the period from 28.02. - 25.04.2025 all long-distance trains and most regional trains do not stop at Bochum central station. During the week only one commuter line (S1) traveling between Dortmund and Essen in both directions stops at Bochum Central. Unfortunately during the weekends this line is substituted by slow busses.

Participants arriving on Monday (or during the week) can still reach Bochum directly by train (S1) but need a bit more time. To reach Bochum, traveling from the south you have to change to S1 at Essen central station. Arriving from the north you have to change to S1 at Dortmund central station.

Participants **arriving on Saturday or Sunday** will have to use a combination of different trains and busses, rail replacement services or other means of transport to reach Bochum. Please refer to the App and plan with more time. We are sorry for the inconvenience.

At Bochum central station take the U 35 Campus line to ZEMOS at Ruhr-University Bochum. After leaving the platform to get to the distributor level either

- 1.) go to the entrance hall (Empfangshalle) and take the stairs or escalator downstairs to the area marked with (U). Look for sign saying 'U35 (Direction: Bochum Hustadt (Querenburg)) and follow them to the platform.
- 2.) Go in the other direction to the exit Buddenbergplatz. Just before the exit look for blue sign saying "U 35 Hustadt (TQ)" on the right and follow the escalator down to the subway platform.



You can leave one stop after Ruhr-Universität Bochum at "Lennershof" station (recommended faster option) and follow directions in the PDF "Lennershof to ZEMOS". Alternatively leave one stop earlier at "Ruhr-Universität Bochum" and follow the directions in the PDF "Ruhr-Universität (U35) to ZEMOS". Both files are also available on the [website](#).
